Bulk Trash Regulations

Bulk trash pick-up will be this November 8th, and there are some things that everyone should know. Key Sanitation is contracted to the Town to pick up **two (2) bulk items per household**. The town will not pay for more bulk items to be removed.

If you have extra bulk items, call **Bob Clark at Key Sanitation** to find out how much removal will cost. Anything above two items is between Key Sanitation & the resident. If you are unsure if your item is bulk trash, or if it is considered hazardous, Bob is also the one to ask—call **301-668-8282**.



Lawn trash which fits in standard brown Yard Waste bags (found in most hardware stores) will be picked up Oct. 26th and Nov. 30th. No rocks, dirt or large branches as usual, thanks!
