Our proclamation was signed at the Town Meeting on September 12th, 2011. In cooperation with the Frederick Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, Mayor Deborah Burgoyne approved the celebration of the 224th anniversary of the signing of the U.S.

Constitution.

After invention and promotion by the DAR, Constitution Week was officially declared by President Eisenhower on August 2, 1956.

Constitution week is more than words on a page. Bells Across America is an event that the Town participated in with organizations & individuals across the entire country.

Yard waste will be picked up on **October 25th** and **November 22nd**.

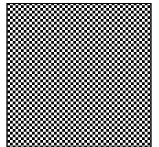
