Frederick County students currently enrolled in college or university in a graduate or undergraduate program, trade School, or certificate program may also apply. Preference will be given to students preparing for a career in government or public service.

The Scholarship committee will take into consideration the following:

- Extracurricular activities
- Involvement within your community
- Scholastic record
- Character

It is important that every question be answered fully and honestly since incomplete answers could lessen the chances of being considered for a scholarship. The essays will be judged on creativity, sincerity of thought, knowledge of municipal government, and proper use of grammar and spelling.

You may apply every year that you are in school but there is no guarantee that you will be selected in successive years. Any person who has previously been awarded this scholarship two (2) successive years will not be awarded a scholarship a third successive year: However, that person may apply the year following, and be considered as a first time applicant.
